Patient with Private Insurance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Insurance plan formulary alternative • Manufacturer co-pay card (pay close attention to max savings with each card) • Discount card programs • Human insulin product (ex. Novolin R, Novolin N) or generic insulin • My \$99 Insulin
Patient with Medicaid	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Insurance plan formulary alternatives • Prior authorization process
Patient with No Insurance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Manufacturer PAP if conditions met • Insulin Valyou savings program • My \$99 insulin • Human insulin product (ex. Novolin R, Novolin N) or generic insulin • Referral to site that offers Pharmacy with 340b status/HRSA registration
